Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

Eligibility at a Glance (Apply to Confirm)

Household must meet certain income and resource limits, and work requirements to be eligible to receive SNAP benefits.

Although not typically eligible for SNAP, students and non-citizens can receive SNAP benefits under specific qualifications.

Non-Citizens:

"Generally, to qualify for SNAP, non-citizens must meet one of the following criteria:

- Have lived in the United States for at least 5 years.
- Be receiving disability-related assistance or benefits.
- Be children under 18."

People experiencing homelessness do not need to meet certain residential requirements.

Women, Infants, and Children Program (WIC)

Eligibility at a Glance (Apply to Confirm)

Applicants must meet all of the following eligibility requirements:

• Categorical: The following individuals are considered categorically eligible for WIC:

Women

Pregnant (during pregnancy and up to 6 weeks after the birth of an infant or the end of the pregnancy)

Postpartum (up to six months after the birth of the infant or the end of the pregnancy)

Breastfeeding (up to the infant's first birthday)

Infants (up to the infant's first birthday)

Children (up to the child's fifth birthday)

- Residential: Applicants must live in the state in which they apply
- Income: Applicants must have income at or below an income level or standard set by the state agency or be determined automatically income-eligible based on participation in certain programs (including SNAP benefits, Medicaid, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, etc.)
- Nutrition Risk: A health professional or WIC staff must determine whether the individual is at nutritional risk.

Non-citizens are eligible to receive WIC benefits if they meet the general eligibility requirements.

Meal Service

Fresh meals are prepared daily at Mt. Alverno Center by a professional food service company.

Meals on Wheels volunteers deliver meals to clients' homes between 11:30am and 1:00pm every weekday (Monday through Friday), including holidays.

Both hot meals and cold meals are available. Hot meals consist of meat, starch, vegetables, milk or juice, bread and butter, and dessert or fruit. Cold meals can be added and include a sandwich, salad, milk or juice and dessert.

Meals are customized to meet dietary needs.

Meal Eligibility

Meals are provided to homebound and/or elderly individuals who are unable to shop or cook for themselves due to age, illness or disability.

Meal Cost

There is a modest charge for meals.

Deliveries are made to residents within the Village of Warwick and some surrounding areas in the Town of Warwick.

To request meals, call Meals on Wheels of Warwick at and leave a voicemail message. A representative will contact you. Meal delivery will start soon after you enroll
