# Tips for Learning at Home

### Be a Home Reading Coach!

Research shows that students who read for one hour every day have a much better chance for success in school and beyond. The more time your child spends reading from books he or she can and wants to read, the better reader he or she will become. We need your help!

Your child should read for at least 30 minutes per night.

# Responsibilities of a Home Reading Coach

Turn off the TV, phone, computers, and games. Eliminate distractions.

☆ Read with your child, or observe him/her reading, for 30 minutes. (For children working at 1R and below, taking breaks may be necessary.)

Think and talk about the books afterward.



Multiplication in third grade is an important concept in our math. Students have learned many ways to get to an answer by drawing models such as arrays and equal groups. They need to spend time reviewing their facts weekly to reach mastery. These are integral to the math that comes later on in the year. There are many ways you can help your child achieve this. There are many free online sights that they can go on. We use Reflex math in school weekly to help students achieve this.
