## **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Serves as the school facilitator of the NECSD NY Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Programs (NYGear Up) program providing school oversight and technical assistance.
- Coordinates and supervises student programming after school.
- Collaborates with the program facilitator and other school facilitators to develop and implement NYGEAR Up programming.
- Designs and coordinates NYGEAR Up programming during the school year and summer months based on student and school needs and in compliance with grant.
- Maintains school programmatic data and collaboratively evaluates effectiveness in a quantifiable way including student academic growth outcomes.
- Collaborates with district and school facilitators to make data informed programmatic decisions.
- Participates in professional development activities required by NYGEAR Up.
