

## SCHOOL AND LIBRARY BUDGET VOTE/ELECTION CALENDAR FOR 2022

In accordance with the provisions of Articles 53 & 41 of the Education Law of the State of New York, governing School Elections and Budget Votes,  
BE IT RESOLVED,

1. That the Board of Education adopts a School & Library Budget Vote/Election Calendar as follows:

PROPOSED SCHOOL & LIBRARY BUDGET ADOPTION (no later than) Friday, April 22, 2022

BUDGET VOTE/ELECTION DAY (12:00 Noon-9:00 p.m.) Tuesday, May 17, 2022

NOMINATING PETITION FORMS AVAILABLE Friday, February 25, 2022

NOMINATING PETITION FORMS RETURNED BY 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, April 27, 2022

PUBLIC HEARING ON BUDGET at 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, May 10, 2022

REGISTRATION DAY (10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. - BOE Lobby) Saturday, April 30, 2022

CANVASS OF VOTES Wednesday, May 18, 2022

2. The following constitute a Board of Registration for one year: Alicia Dosio, Susan Kaplan

3. That at least three qualified inspectors be appointed for each election district-polling place, appointment to be made on or before April 19, 2022.

4. That the pay for members of the Board of Registration and Election Inspectors be established at the rate of \$135.00 per day, except for the Chairperson of Inspectors and Machine Operators at each poll who will receive \$150.00 per day. Election Inspectors/Machine Operators will also receive additional \$25.00 for participating in the Election Inspectors workshop training.

5. That the use of voting machines be approved for this election and vote.

6. That voting machine technicians be appointed for the election/vote, the number of and pay for such technicians as determined by the Orange County Board of Elections.

7. That the Superintendent of Schools or District Clerk be authorized to proceed with the printing of forms and publishing of legal advertisements necessary for this budget vote/election.

NOTES: (a) Three (3) candidates are to be elected for three-year terms (July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2025).
